Apply for the CSEA Dependent Scholarship

Are your children graduating from high school this year and headed off to college next Fall? Are they already attending college? CSEA has scholarships available for your dependents to apply.

CSEA \$1,000 Dependent Scholarships - Application Deadline is February 1, 2024 CSEA offers \$1,000 scholarships to dependents of CSEA members. Applications must be submitted along with all required documentation by February 1, 2024.

Pre-Application Worksheet -The Dependent Scholarship Application is an online form. There is no time limit to completing the application, however, your dependent will need to complete the application in one sitting, as there is no option to save your work and go back to it later. We have created this worksheet so you can make sure you have everything necessary for successful submission of the application.

Online Application Form - Feel free to forward this email to you dependents or have them go directly to www.csea.com/scholarships so they can read about the scholarship, download the Pre-Application Worksheet, complete the application, and submit the application with required documentation.

Union Plus Scholarships - \$500 to \$4,000

CSEA members and dependents are also eligible to apply for the Union Plus Scholarship with awards ranging from \$500 to \$4,000. Apply online by January 31, 2024.
